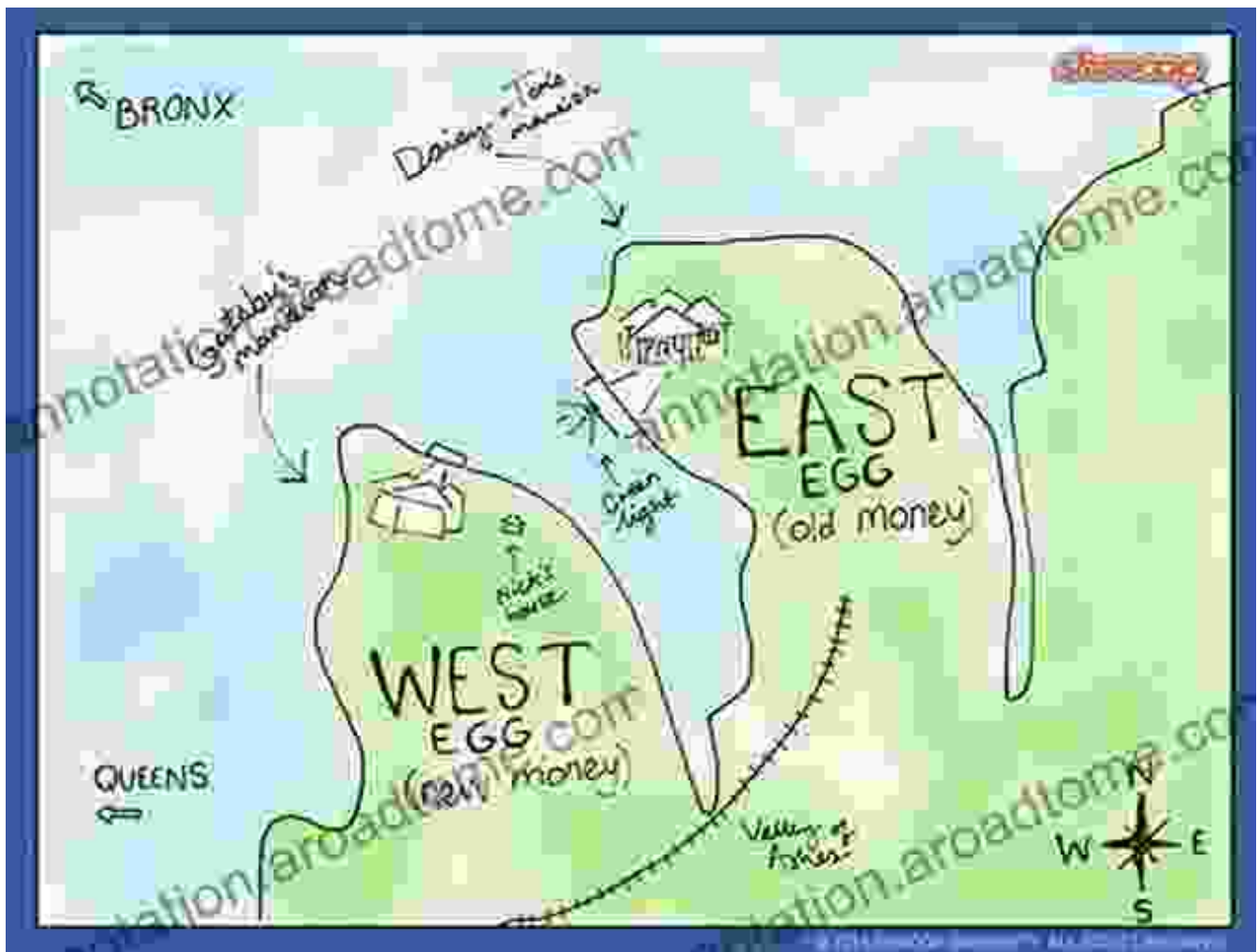
Literary Map of Nantucket from Herman Melville's Moby Dick

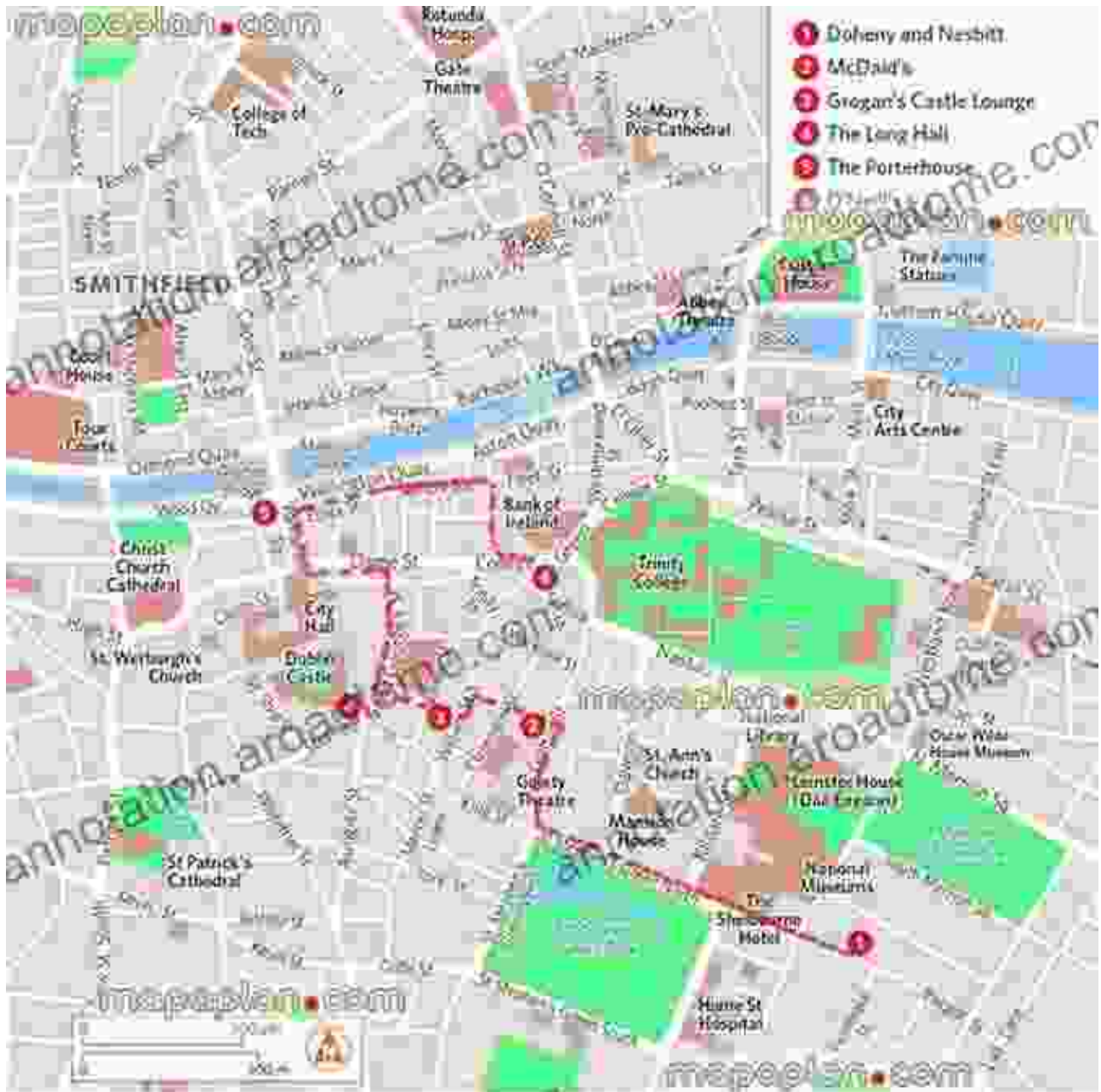

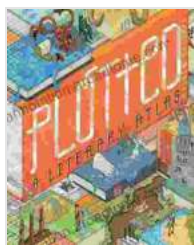
Literary Map of Dublin from James Joyce's Dubliners

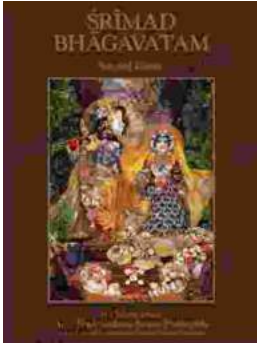
